OLD BUSINESS

CORNWALL ASSOCIATES – LETTERS OF CREDIT REDUCTION

Marie Tribioli made the motion, seconded by Ron Ricard to cancel Letter of Credit #'s: D003675 for Phase 1, D004188 for Phase 1A, D004725 for Phase 2, D006284 not identified to any phase. The remaining work to be done for these phases has been added to letter of credit for Phase 3 #D006890. Motion passed.

FERAL CAT ORDINANCE

Marie Tribioli made the motion, seconded by Beth Yocum to amend the Borough's Nuisance Ordinance to add the following language:

302.5 – Rodent and Wild Animal Harborage and Infestation. All structures and exterior property shall be maintained in a manner to prevent rodent and wild animal harborage, feeding, and infestation.

302.5.1 – Where rodents are found, they shall be promptly exterminated by approved processes which will not be injurious to human health. After extermination, proper precautions shall be taken to eliminate rodent harborage and prevent re-infestation.

302.5.2 – No occupant of a property shall attract or feed wild and or stray domestic animals, including, but not limited to, stray cats, stray dogs, skunks and squirrels. Nothing contained herein shall prohibit occupants from feeding birds using bird feeders or other receptacles. In connection with the feeding of wild birds, this prohibition shall include scattering, broadcasting, dropping or placing any corn, seeds, feed or bread on the ground, deck or any surface not used as recognized common bird feeders. This prohibition shall include the feeding of any wild and/or stray domestic animals recognizing that skunks, raccoons, ground hogs, and similar wild animals will be attracted by the placement of a food source in the exterior of a premises within a bird feeder.

Motion passed with Al Brandt and Gerald Boughter to vote nay.

BLIGHT ORDINANCE
